U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Announced Additional Opportunity for Funding

On June 9, 2020, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) announced additional distributions from the Provider Relief Fund.

Approximately \$15 billion nationally will be distributed to eligible Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) providers that participate in state Medicaid and CHIP programs and that have not already received funds from the Provider Relief Fund. These payments will not be made automatically. Providers need to go to the federal portal to apply for this support. Eligible providers must have directly billed either their state Medicaid/CHIP programs (DHS) or Medicaid-managed care plans for health care-related services during the period of January 1, 2018, to May 31, 2020.
