Change in Claim Submission for Medicare Members for COVID-19 Vaccines and Monoclonal Antibody Treatment

Effective for dates of service beginning January 1, 2022, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota and Blue Plus (Blue Cross) will require claims for COVID-19 vaccine administration and monoclonal antibody infusions for treatment of COVID-19 for Medicare Advantage, Platinum Blue (Medicare Cost), and Minnesota Senior Health Options (MSHO) subscribers to be submitted to Blue Cross. When the COVID-19 vaccine or monoclonal antibody is provided by the government at no cost to the provider, only the administration code may be billed on the claim.

Blue Cross encourages providers to work with patients to ensure vaccinations are obtainable for all patients and will cover the administration of the COVID-19 vaccine in an individual's residence.
