Update: Prior Authorization Quick Look Up Tool

The information in this Provider Quick Point replaces QP41-19, published on May 8, 2019. The only change is the effective date is now May 23, 2019. The previous publication had an effective date of May 19, 2019.

On May 23, 2019, a new feature will be added to the Availity® Provider Portal to enable providers to quickly determine if an Authorization is required. By entering Member Group Number, Date of Service and Procedure Code, the tool will indicate whether an Authorization is required. If an Authorization is not required, the tool will allow the user to print the results for their records. If an Authorization is required, the user will move directly into the next field in Authorization application to complete the request.

This new feature is accessible for lines of business managed by Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota and Blue Plus (Blue Cross). For Medicaid, MinnesotaCare and MSHO providers can use the tools AmeriGroup offers for managing Authorizations.

To access this new feature:

- 1. Log in at **Availity.com**
- 2. Select Patient Registration, choose Authorizations & Referrals, then Authorizations
- 3. Select Payer BCBSMN, your Organization, Transaction Type Outpatient and you'll be redirected to the Authorization Look Up Tool application
