July 2015 HCPCS Code Updates

In compliance with HIPAA requirements, effective with dates of service on or after July 1, 2015, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota and Blue Plus (Blue Cross) will accept the following 2015 HCPCS* Level II (alphanumeric) code additions, revisions and deletions.

Because there is no grace period for discontinued codes, if a discontinued code is submitted with a date of service of July 1, 2015, or after, the claim will be rejected. Likewise, added codes will be rejected if submitted with a date of service before July 1, 2015.

Code list

HCPCS and CPT codes are generally only published once a year; however, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid (CMS) or the American Medical Association (AMA) may publish added, revised and/or deleted codes on a quarterly basis. As a courtesy to our providers, we are publishing the added and discontinued codes below.
