Requirements for clinical supervision under the new Minnesota Rule part 9505.0371

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota and Blue Plus (Blue Cross) requires clinical supervision to comply with Minnesota Rule part 9505.0371 which was adopted and implemented on June 28, 2011. Please refer to the Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) Bulletin #11-53-03 for requirements related to clinical supervision.

The Rule addresses standards in the following areas:

- Eligibility of a supervisor
- Eligibility of a supervisee
- Individual and group supervision
- Clinical supervision plan for each person under supervision
- Documentation of a supervision session
- When clinical supervision documentation is required in a client's chart

Blue Cross will continue to allow clinical supervision that meets the requirement of the new Rule to be done in the following clinic settings:

- Rule 29 Licensed Clinics
- Community Mental Health Centers
- Behavioral Health Clinics as defined by Blue Cross
- Mental Health Designated Essential Community Providers
- Multispecialty Clinics
