MHCP members need to utilize Blue Distinction Centers for Bariatric Surgery®

In 2006, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota and Blue Plus (Blue Cross) began participating in the program that is now called called Blue Distinction Centers for Bariatric Surgery[®]. This program requires facilities to meet evidence-based quality measures in order to receive the Blue Distinction designation. The facilities also need to be redesignated and continue to meet criteria on a regular basis in order to maintain their high quality designation.

As a reminder, bariatric surgery services for Minnesota Health Care Programs (MHCP) members ages 18 and older will be eligible for reimbursement only if performed by a Blue Plus network provider in a facility that is one of the Blue Distinction Centers for Bariatic Surgery. The list of designated facilities may change over time, so be sure to call provider services before referring a member to a particular facility. The following facilities are currently included:

All bariatric surgery requires pre-certification/pre-authorization. Please consult the Blue Cross Medical and Behavioral Health Policy Manual located on **providers.bluecrossmn.com** for details. Pre-certification consists of a medical necessity review using MHCP guidelines for bariatric surgery.
