## October 2009 HCPCS and ICD-9-CM code updates

The National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS) and the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) released the 2010 ICD-9-CM (International Classification of Diseases, ninth revision, Clinical Modification) updates. CMS has also published several HCPCS Level II coding changes.

### Submitting

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota and Blue Plus will accept all added ICD-9-CM and HCPCS codes October 1, 2009 or the effective date of the code(s).

Because there is no grace period for invalid or discontinued codes, if a discontinued/invalid code is submitted with a date of service of October 1, 2009 or after, the claim will be rejected. Likewise, added codes will be rejected if submitted with a date of service before October 1, 2009.

### Code list

The HCPCS added, revised, and discontinued code list is below. The ICD-9-CM diagnosis codes are not available from Blue Cross. ICD-9-CM manuals are available from several sources such as the American Medical Association, Ingenix, or major bookstores. Blue Cross will accept all added ICD-9-CM and HCPCS codes effective on October 1, 2009, unless otherwise noted.

### Added codes:

G9141	Influenza A (H1N1) immunization administration (includes the physician counseling the patient/family) <i>NOTE: This code is effective September 1, 2009</i>
G9142	Influenza A (H1N1) vaccine, any route of administration <i>NOTE: This code is effective September 1, 2009</i>
Q2024	Injection, Bevacizumab, 0.25 mg
S3713	Kras mutation analysis testing

### Revised code:

S0605	Digital rectal examination, <u>male</u> , annual

### Discontinued code:

S0162	Injection, efalizumab, 125 mg
