## Update: Claims submission requirements for Intensive Residential Treatment Services and Residential Crisis Stabilization

Effective July 15, 2009, Minnesota Statute 62J.536 will require health care providers and group purchasers (payers, plans) to comply with the claims submission requirements published by the Administrative Uniformity Committee (AUC) in the Minnesota Uniform Companion Guide. The Minnesota Uniform Companion Guide is available at <a href="www.health.state.mn.us/auc/index.html">www.health.state.mn.us/auc/index.html</a>. Please consult the Minnesota Uniform Companion Guide for the specific submission requirements.

Effective July 15, 2009, the claims submission requirements published in the Minnesota Uniform Companion Guide replace any previous claims submission instructions from Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota and Blue Plus related to revenue codes, HCPCS codes or type of bill.
