

**July 2008 HCPCS code update**

Effective July 1, 2008, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota and Blue Plus will accept the quarterly Level II (alphanumeric) and Level I (CPT) HCPCS\* additions, revisions and deletions published by the Centers of Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and the American Medical Association (AMA).

**Submitting codes**

Blue Cross will accept all added HCPCS codes effective on July 1, 2008.

**Code list**

HCPCS and CPT manuals are generally only published once a year; however, CMS or AMA may publish added, revised and/or deleted codes on a quarterly basis. The codes listed below are effective July 1, 2008 unless otherwise specified.

CG	Policy criteria applied
C9242	Injection, fosaprepitant, 1 mg
C9356	Tendon, porous matrix of cross-linked collagen and glycosaminoglycan matrix (TenoGlide Tendon Protector Sheet), per square centimeter
C9357	Dermal substitute, granulated cross-linked collagen and glycosaminoglycan matrix (Flowable Wound Matrix), 1 cc
C9358	Dermal substitute, native, non-denatured collagen (SurgiMend Collagen Matrix), per 0.5 square centimeters
G0398	Home sleep study test (HST) with type II portable monitor, unattended; minimum of 7 channels: EEG, EOG, EMG, ECG/heart rate, airflow, respiratory effort and oxygen saturation
G0399	Home sleep test (HST) with type III portable monitor, unattended; minimum of 4 channels: 2 respiratory movement/airflow, 1 ECG/heart rate and 1 oxygen saturation
G0400	Home sleep test (HST) with type IV portable monitor, unattended; minimum of 3 channels
90738	Japanese encephalitis virus vaccine, inactivated, for intramuscular use
3351F	Negative screen for depressive symptoms as categorized by using a standardized depression screening/assessment too (MDD)
3352F	No significant depressive symptoms as categorized by using a standardized depression screening/assessment too (MDD)
3353F	Mild to moderate depressive symptoms as categorized by using a standardized depression screening/assessment too (MDD)
3354F	Clinically significant depressive symptoms as categorized by using a standardized depression screening/assessment too (MDD)
0188T	Remote real-time interactive videoconferenced critical care, evaluation and management of the critically ill or critically injured patient; first 30-74 minutes
0189T	Remote real-time interactive videoconferenced critical care, evaluation and management of the critically ill or critically injured patient; each additional 30 minutes (List separately in addition to code for primary service)
0190T	Placement of intraocular radiation source applicator (List separately in addition to primary procedure)
0191T	Insertion of anterior segment aqueous drainage device, without extraocular reservoir; internal approach
0192T	Insertion of anterior segment aqueous drainage device, without extraocular reservoir; external approach

0124T	Conjunctival incision with posterior <del>juxtascleral</del> <u>extrascleral</u> placement of pharmacological agent (does not include supply of medication)
