Legislative Change in Circumcision Service Delivery for Members of Minnesota Health Care Programs

For members of Minnesota Health Care Programs, claims payment for newborn circumcision, which was previously the responsibility of the Department of Human Services, is the responsibility of Blue Plus as of January 1, 2008. Circumcision coverage will now be limited to only those procedures which are medically necessary (a pathologic condition exists that requires circumcision). This limitation applies to circumcision for all ages. The newborn circumcision exception for religious practice was eliminated July 1, 2007.

A prior authorization will be required for all circumcisions for determination of medical necessity.

This legislative change in circumcision benefits and claims processing applies to members in all Minnesota Health Care Programs (MHCP) products:
