Infusion pumps for Minnesota Health Care Programs (MHCP) members

Blue Plus will follow the Department of Human Services (DHS) process as outlined in the MHCP Manual for infusion pumps. The link to the DHS information is:

Effective July 15, 2011, Blue Plus will require pre-authorization for the following infusion pumps for which DHS requires authorization.

Procedure code	Description
E0782	Infusion pump, implantable, non-programmable (includes all components, e.g., pump, catheter, connections, etc.)
E0783	Infusion pump system, implantable, programmable (includes all components, e.g., pump, catheter, connections, etc.)
E0784	External ambulatory infusion pump, insulin
E0786	Implantable programmable infusion pump, replacement (excludes implantable intraspinal catheter)
K0455	Infusion pump used for uninterrupted parenteral administration of medication, (e.g., epoprostenol or treprostinol)
