Blue Cross prepares systems to accept electronic pharmacy and dental formatted claims

Minnesota statute 62J.536, requires providers to submit all claims electronically beginning July 15, 2009. This requirement includes dental and pharmacy formatted claim types.

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota and Blue Plus and its affiliates are completing system changes to accept and properly adjudicate these electronic claim types. Due to the complexity of the changes and need for extensive testing, Blue Cross can not accept dental formatted or pharmacy formatted electronic claims until first quarter 2010. Pharmacy and dental providers should continue to submit these claim types on paper until first quarter 2010. You will receive additional communication when these system changes have been completed.
