

Individuals must be Minnesota residents in order to purchase or renew individual market coverage from Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota or Blue Plus. “Individual market coverage” means an individual or family plan you buy on your own, not coverage through your employer. To verify that an individual resides in Minnesota, and, as applicable, in the relevant health plan service area, Blue Cross or Blue Plus may request additional information and/or documentation from the individual or his/her representative.

Forms of accepted documentation include, for instance, at least one or more of the following:

- Copy of rental agreement or lease
- Copies of previous and new driver’s license
- Copy of utility bill
- Copy of voter registration card
- Copies of closing papers on a housing purchase
- Letter from your Minnesota employer
- Copy(ies) of visa with I-94, and/or other documents permitting residency in the United States
- Completed Special Enrollment Period MN Residency Questionnaire
- Other documentation you wish to provide
