New Pre-Authorization Form for Immunoglobulin Therapy

As previously announced in "Prior Authorization/Pre-Approval Forms Specific to Select Medical Policies" (QP12-17), a new pre-authorization (PA) form, "Immunoglobulin Therapy Pre-Authorization Request Form (Medical Policy II-51)" will be available on November 13, 2017, for pre–authorization requests for Immunoglobulin Therapy (Medical Policy II-51).

The Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota and Blue Plus (Blue Cross) Immunoglobulin Therapy PA form is based upon Blue Cross medical policy (II-97) criteria. Blue Cross medical policy (II-97) is used for both commercial products and Government programs products: Prepaid Medical Assistance Program (PMAP), MinnesotaCare and Minnesota Senior Care Plus (MSC+).

The preferred method of submitting a pre-authorization for drugs is electronically via our free **Availity** provider portal. However, any of the following methods of PA for Immunoglobulin Therapy will be accepted:

- Electronic PA via Availity, or
- A National Council for Prescription Drug Programs (NCPDP) standard XML file through CenterX, via an integrated electronic medical record (EMR) system, or
- The new Immunoglobulin Therapy fax form

Pre-authorization requests for Immunoglobulin Therapy that do not use the specific pre-authorization form will not be denied because the specific form was not completed and submitted for the pre-authorization. However, the intent of the creation of specific pre-authorization forms is to reduce the number of pre-authorization denials for incomplete or incorrect information and to reduce the amount of interaction needed between Blue Cross and the provider to identify all the clinical information needed for the most appropriate outcome for both the provider and the subscriber.

An approved PA does not guarantee a medication is covered under a subscriber's benefit plan. Subscriber benefit plans vary in coverage and some plans may not provide coverage for certain services discussed in the medical policies.
