## Changes to Prior Authorization for Hip Arthroplasty, Hip Resurfacing and Knee Arthroplasty for Commercial and Government Programs Lines of Business

Effective March 12, 2018, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota and Blue Plus (Blue Cross) will be **removing** the following services from the Prior Authorization list for Commercial and Government Programs lines of business:

#### **Commercial:**

- IV-107 Hip Arthroplasty (Hip Replacement) and Hip Resurfacing
- IV-122 Knee Arthroplasty

#### **Government Programs:**

- InterQual: Hip Arthroplasty (Hip Replacement)
- InterQual: Knee Arthroscopic Knee Debridement

### **Products Impacted**

- This PA program applies to subscribers that have coverage through Commercial and Prepaid Medical Assistance Program (PMAP), MinnesotaCare (MNCare), SecureBlue (MSHO), Minnesota Senior Care Plus (MSC+), Medicare Supplement (Senior Gold, Basic Medicare Blue and Extended Basic Blue), Medicare Advantage or Platinum Blue health plans.
- The changes do not impact Federal Employee Program (FEP) as that line of business has separate PA requirements
