### **Revised: Provider Price Disclosure Requirement**

*The information in this Bulletin replaces Provider Bulletin P43-18, which was published on September 4, 2018. The reason for this revision is due to the effective date incorrectly communicated as January 1, 2019. The correct effective date is July 1, 2019.*

Effective July 1, 2019, in accordance with Minnesota Statute 62.J.81, Providers must provide patients with information regarding other types of fees or charges that the patient may be required to pay in conjunction with a visit to the Provider, including but not limited to any applicable facility fees, within ten business days from the day of a completed request. In addition, Providers must maintain a list of the services over \$25.00 that correspond with the Provider's 25 most frequently billed current procedural terminology (CPT) codes. This list shall be updated annually and must be posted in the Provider's reception area of the clinic or office and made available on the Provider's Website if the Provider maintains a Website. No contract between a Provider and Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota and Blue Plus (Blue Cross) prohibits any of these price disclosures. Price disclosure is not a guarantee of final costs for Health Services received nor a final determination of eligibility of coverage.
