Minnesota Health Care Programs Housing Stabilization Referrals

Housing Stabilization Services are non-waivered services for Minnesota Health Care Programs eligible enrollees with disabilities and seniors to help find and keep stable housing as approved by the Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS). Approvals for the Housing Consultation, Transition/Sustaining services and any exceptions are determined by DHS.

Effective immediately all providers are able to make a member referral to the Housing Stabilization Service program using form DHS-7122. Instructions are provided under DHS-7122A.
