Required Notification of Medicare Organization Determination Request Dismissal and Withdrawal

Starting June 10, 2022, in compliance with CMS guidelines for Part C plans, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota (Blue Cross) will mail a letter to both the member and provider when a request for prior authorization or Organization Determination is withdrawn or dismissed. This new letter will be sent only for Medicare Advantage and Platinum Blue members. **No action is required unless you wish to ask for the withdrawal to be vacated or reconsidered.**

The notice will state all of the following:

- 1. The reason for the dismissal.
- 2. The right to request that the Medicare Advantage organization vacate the dismissal action.
- 3. The right to request reconsideration of the dismissal.

In addition, providers who use the Authorization tool within the Availity Essentials® Portal to withdraw requests will see a small change in the drop-down values presented for Medicare requests. To withdraw a previously submitted request from the Update screen, select "By Provider" and then "Request for withdrawal" to complete the request.
