

These plans provide vision coverage only. Your vision plan's benefit booklet will contain more details on standard plan exclusions and frequency limitations. Davis Vision is an independent company providing vision benefit management services and access to their network.

Each provider in the network is an independent contractor and is not our agent. If you receive services from a nonparticipating provider, you will be responsible for the difference between what Blue Cross will reimburse and what the provider bills.

^{†††}Visually required (also known as medically necessary) means that optimal visual correction cannot be achieved with prescription eyeglasses but can be achieved with contact lens wear. Conditions that may commonly justify visually required lenses include keratoconus, anisometropia, aniseikonia, high astigmatism, pathological myopia, post-traumatic disorders, aphakia, aniridia, and certain corneal conditions.


